Once you have uploaded the plugin either by ftp or through the wordpress upload function. Activate and you will have a new menu link:



On the plugin page we have a list of the products and the option to add a new coupon code.



1.) Select a product that you want to attach a coupon.

2.) Enter the coupon code - which you can give anyone you want to offer the discount, such as your previous customers and mailing list.

3.) Enter a number for the discount amount, if you want to offer a set amount such as \$20 off. Just enter 20, for a % percentage amount it can be anything between 1-99. The coupon addon currently cannot provide a 100% off (i.e. free).

4.) Select the discount type.

5.) Valid till, click in the box and a date selection will popup.

One last thing to make you aware of, you can also select the '**All**' option and the coupon will work for any product you have setup and for sale.





This will display a new 'Minimum Purchase Amount' option that is required:

Now using the '**All**' option is perfectly fine for any situation. But it does depend on what prices you have on products. What I mean by that, if you also selected the discount type as a set amount (\$ USD) make sure the discount is less than the lowest priced product.

If your lowest price product was \$15 for example, and you entered Discount Amount of '**10**' you would enter '**10.01**' or higher in the 'Minimum Purchase Amount' box.

The discount cannot be higher than the minimum purchase, for an easy life use the % discount type, it's nice an easy, you can simply enter '**1**' in the minimum purchase amount! ☺

Once you have setup any coupon codes, you can view them for each individual product and option to edit or delete them.

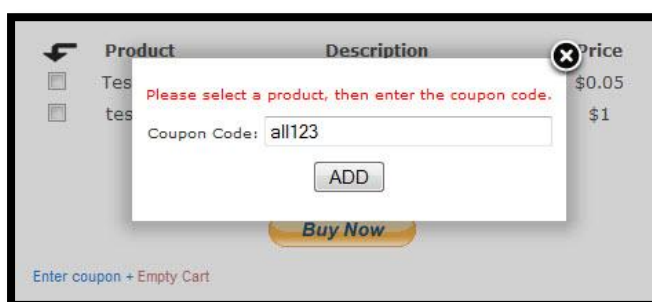

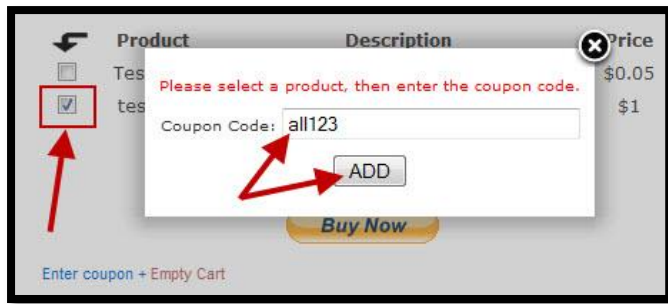
And here's what it looks like to the customer:



The visitor clicks the 'Enter Coupon' and will get a popup:



As it states, the visitor must first select a product before they can enter the coupon code.



Once a valid coupon is entered the visitor gets the message below and also displays the code used.



The visitor can click the 'Empty Cart' link, which will refresh the page and clear the coupon and any products selected.

That's it once you have added your coupon codes, the addon is ready to use 😊
