Thank you for purchasing the WPSA email2list addon. I appreciate your custom, if you have any questions please contact me at my [help desk](#).

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Please note: all WPSA addons are installed exactly like a normal plugin.

Once you have uploaded the plugin either by ftp or through the wordpress upload function. Activate and you will have a new menu link:



Click the menu link, and we have the 3 options

Aweber
GetResponse
Generic

Aweber Option

Now before we go any further, if you have NOT yet setup a subscription in WPSA. Please do that now, even if it's just a test subscription. Reason being only when you have subscriptions will the next option be displayed:

Web Forms menu:



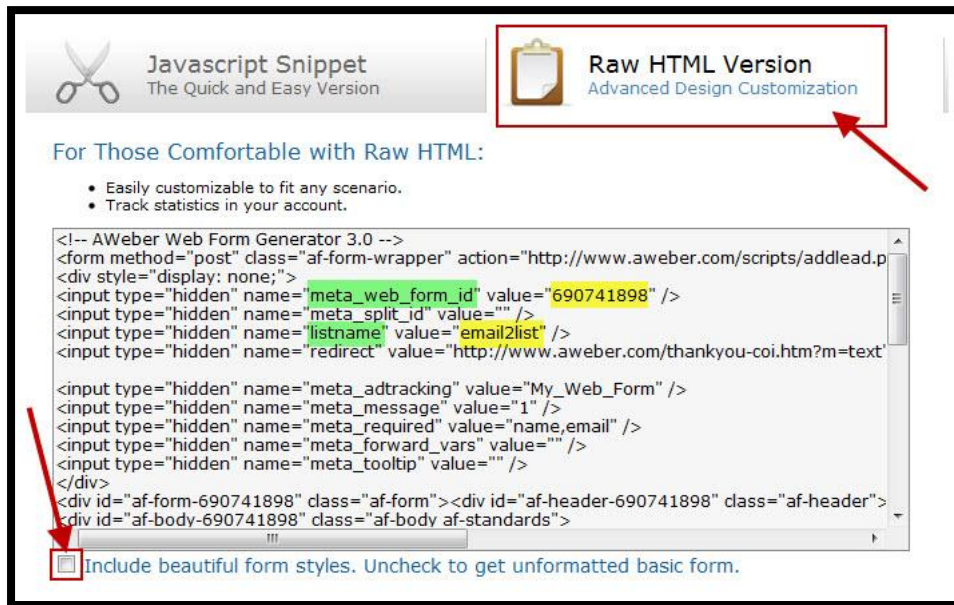
If you haven't already create a new form, once you've done that and completed each step. We need to select the first option.

GetResponse Option

I don't personally have a GR account, so cannot go into detail how to setup and use with the plugin. But you simply need to enter the 'campaign' name, so once you setup a campaign in your GR account copy&paste the campaign name into the plugin field.



Generic Option

This is option can be used to send the signup details via email. So if you use a autorsponder script on your own server, this is how you send the data. Simply enter the email address.

Subscription	Subscription Email Addr.

Now the last option is the details we want added to the registration form after a customer completes the paypal subscription.


